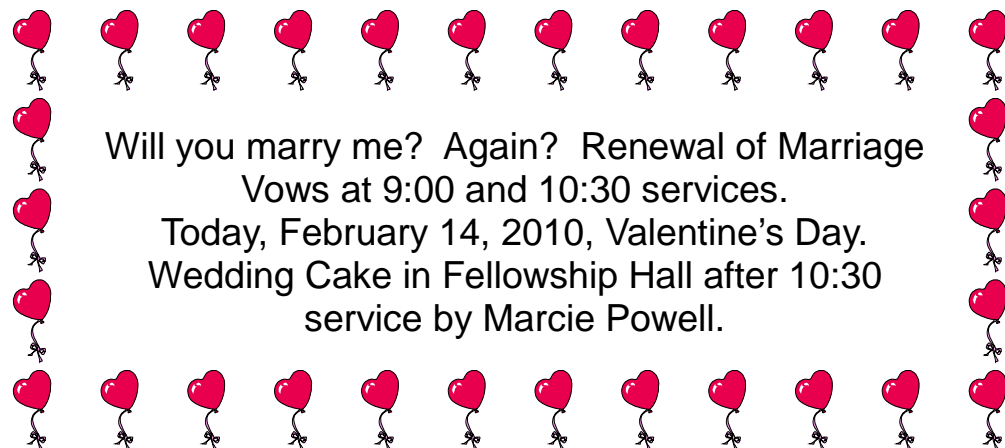
As of February 28, 2010, Conni Ernst will be resigning as Director of Christian Education and Communications. Applications are available in the Church Office.

## BRAINSTORMING IDEAS FROM YOUR STEWARDSHIP COMMITTEE

Your Stewardship Committee met January 10<sup>th</sup> to brainstorm ideas on ways to increase revenue for our church budget. We just tossed out ideas with a brief explanation. Here is a list of those ideas:

Antique Auction, Silent Auction, Auction for individual service: (wash cars, wash dishes, clean yards, shop for groceries, etc.), Monthly Community Open Market in church parking lot, Special Note: UMW will have one rummage sale from August 8-12 (Sunday through Thursday). People will bring in their items to the sale rather than bringing items in ahead of time. Items brought to the church throughout the rest of the year may be sold at the yard sales. Run one paper route with volunteers taking a certain day each week, Recycle Materials, Recycling Center: become an authorized recycling center, Participate in a specific grocery store or gasoline station that has a Community Card (they refund a percentage of your purchased amount back to the church), Provide ground delivery service to New Mexico, Arizona, Nevada, and California, Fund Raisers that sell things like cookie dough, candy, etc. (stay clear of gambling type items), Change the Parish House back into a home either to rent or to use for the pastor, Serve spaghetti dinners or barbecues, Become a vendor at farmer markets, Continue to find groups who want to use our church facilities and will pay for that usage.

We will most likely pursue some of these ideas. We would appreciate feedback from the congregation. Members working on these ideas and/or members of the committee are: Darlene Osborn, Donna Kulasxa, Janice and George Hoskins, Rhoma and Wyatt Lynch, Lew Lazowitz, Dr. Bob Ness, and Jim and Judy Baun.

### MISSION Alert!

Baja Mexico was hit by floods 2 weeks ago. Murray Hawkins, President of the Joint Commission, has been to the area to check out the conditions. A violent flash flood hit Baja and entire communities were washed out. Most people were rescued but they have lost everything. A local seminary (Methodist) is serving 300 meals a day to the now homeless people.

The challenge is to support the people of San Ramon with emergency food, clothing, household items, etc. until homes can be rebuilt. Work teams will be needed to go into the area and help with the rebuilding. UMCOR is there and helping with the feeding program and blankets but more is needed.
